

Possible: present in suitable breeding habitat on at least one visit during breeding season. **Probable**: singing/displaying male in suitable breeding site on more than one visit during breeding season; pair showing courtship or territorial behaviour; pair visiting probable nest site; nest building; anxiety calls.

Confirmed: adult/ pair carrying food or faecal sac; adult sitting on nest; nest with eggs/young; recently fledged young (indicate number of broods rather than individual young).
